What is the Hegelian Dialectic? PART: 3 (final)

Dialectical materialism changed the Hegelian formula in several crucial ways. First they excluded God's law from the formula altogether, and then they pitted a lie against a lie, claiming the result was a perfect synthesis. Their theory of inexorable, inevitable world evolution into totalitarian communism was attained via the Hegelian dialectic. The modern theory of global spiritual evolution into global communitarian collectives was as well. Transformational Marxism is the Hegelian dialectic applied materially, as opposed to ideally. **The Soviet Union**

was based on the Hegelian dialectic, as is all Marxist writing. The Soviets didn't give up Hegelian reasoning when they supposedly stopped being a communist country, they simply modernized their language. [Hegel Resources from Andy Blunden](#). Mr. Blunden is an Australian communist who studies Hegel's contributions to totalitarian "dictatorships of the people." American author Steve Montgomery explores Moscow's adept use of the Hegelian dialectic in **Glasnost-Perestroika: A Model Potemkin Village**. For a lengthy analysis of Hegel's dialectical reasoning, the University of Idaho has an online version of **Studies in the Hegelian Dialectic** by John Ellis McTaggart (1896). In *Chapter VI: The Final Result of the Dialectic*, the author explains the confusion inherent in Hegel's philosophy: "Hegel taught that the secrets of the universe opened themselves to us, but only on condition of deep & systematic thought, & the importance of philosophy was undiminished either by skepticism or by appeals to the healthy instincts of the plain man. But there is some difference between taking philosophy as the supreme-completely adequate means & admitting it to be the supreme end. There is some difference between holding that philosophy is the knowledge of the highest form of reality and holding that it is itself the highest form of reality. It seems to me that Hegel has been untrue to the tendencies of his own system in seeking the ultimate reality of Spirit in philosophy alone and that, on his own premises, he ought to have looked for a more comprehensive explanation." Biography George Washington Born February 22, 1732, in



Westmoreland County, Va., George Washington was the first son of his father Augustine's second marriage; his mother was the former Mary Ball of Epping Forest. Washington's father died in 1743. He divided his adolescence among the households of relatives, finding a home and a model in his half-brother Lawrence at Mount Vernon. From Lawrence, Washington learned trigonometry and surveying and cultivated a taste for ethics, novels, music, and the theater. A ranking officer in the

Virginia militia, Lawrence had served with Admiral Edward Vernon – for whom the plantation was named – and thus imbued George with aspirations for military service. Another early influence on George Washington was the powerful Fairfax family of neighboring Belvoir, who introduced him to the accomplishments and proprieties of mannered wealth and provided him his first adventure. In 1748, Lord Fairfax sent George with a party that spent a month surveying Fairfax lands in the still-wild Shenandoah Valley. It was on this expedition that George began to appreciate the uses and value of land, an appreciation that grew the following year with his appointment as Culpeper County surveyor, certified by the College of William & Mary. Brother Lawrence, suffering from a lung complaint, undertook a Barbados voyage in search of health in a warmer climate, and George accompanied him. The younger brother contracted smallpox and returned to Virginia alone, but with an immunity to a disease that later ravaged colonial-era armies. Lawrence died in 1752. Washington succeeded to Lawrence's militia office. Governor Robert Dinwiddie first appointed him adjutant for the southern district of the colony's militia, but soon conferred on him Lawrence's adjutancy for the Northern Neck and Eastern Shore. And so it happened that in 1753 the governor sent 21-year-old George Washington to warn French troops stationed north of the forks of the Ohio River (modern Pittsburgh) that they were encroaching in territory claimed by Virginia. What can't be found is the story we were taught in school that George Washington chopped down a cherry tree and unable to lie admitted it, I can still remember cutting out cherries and hatchets to decorate my school class room. Too bad some of the victories and important actions were never considered worthy of filling our empty heads with the brave deeds and true patriotic statesmanship George Washington possessed, **IF YOU THINK YOU KNOW GEORGE WASHINGTON, THINK AGAIN.** Glenn Beck wrote **Being George Washington** an amazing true story of a real-life superhero who changed the world forever. It's a story about a man whose life reads as if it were torn from the pages of an action novel: Bullet holes through his clothing, horses shot out from under him and facing. He suffered unimaginable hardships, disease, heroism, spies and double-agents. And, of course, the unmistakable hand of Divine Providence that guided it all. Being George Washington is a whole new way to look at history. You won't simply read about the awful winter spent at Valley Forge—you'll live it right alongside

Washington. You'll be on the boat with him crossing the Delaware, in the trenches with him at Yorktown, and standing next to him at the Constitutional Convention as a new republic is finally born. Through these stories you'll not only learn our real history (and how it applies to today), you'll also see how the media and others have distorted our view of it. It's ironic that the best-known fact about George Washington—that he chopped down a cherry tree—is a complete lie. It's even more ironic when you consider that a lie was thought necessary to prove he could not tell one. For all of his heroism and triumphs, Washington's single greatest accomplishment was the man he created in the process: courageous and principled, fair and just, respectful to all. But he was also something else: flawed. It's those flaws that should give us hope for today. After all, if Washington had been perfect, then there would be no way to build another one. That's why this book is not just about being Washington in 1776; it's about the struggle to be him every single day of our lives. Understanding the way he turned himself from an uneducated farmer into the Indispensable (yet imperfect) Man, is the only way to build a new generation of George Washingtons that can take on the extraordinary challenges that America is once again facing.

Precinct Committeeman: Most Powerful Office in the World! Want to motivate the wimpy Republicans-In-Name-Only to start following the Constitution? The current Party leadership would be afraid the "new conservative blood" would throw them out in the next election. The incumbents would fear that the "new conservative blood" would endorse the best conservative challenger in the primary instead of endorsing them. The only fear that will motivate them is the fear of losing their jobs. Precinct committeemen are in the BEST position to make that happen. **FYI Republican lawmakers are demanding the names and access
to the survivors of Benghazi.** To date, Sec. of State John Kerry has
